


Correlation of H2020 funding and GERD in million EUR

In EU-13 Countries






- Budget: 6.27 MEUR (EU contribution 5.37 MEUR)




- 23 supported projects (out of 458 proposals) in the special coronavirus call of May 2020



- Key innovation: an artificial chemist algorithm, which can generate virtual compounds using chemicals from known supplier partners and selected robust chemical reactions. This offers scientists the opportunity to work with unprecedented molecules of high patentable potential and identify drug-like compounds that didn't previously exist.

Developing support mechanisms & institutions



- Extended network of National Contact Points
- Horizon Europe contact points at regional/institutional level in higher education institutions (within the frames of the university innovation ecosystem -EIÖ call)- in close cooperation with the National Contact Point network;
- Network of international coordinators in National Laboratories
- Liaison office in Brussels- representation, networking, obtaining information, lobbying

Cooperation with Horizon Europe proposal evaluators



- Promoting the get involved in Horizon Europe evaluation activities (recruiting new expert evaluators at the launch of Horizon Europe)

- Organizing regular discussion fora for evaluators to share experience
- Using the support of evaluators in Horizon Europe consultancy (events, trainings, pre-evaluations)

Incentives in the Hungarian RDI funding portfolio



- Providing bonus score to applicants with FP7 and Horizon 2020 history in the case of programmes aiming at innovative companies
- Introducing target indicators and commitments related to the number of submitted proposals and funded projects in Horizon Europe in national calls aiming at supporting higher education institutions and research organisations.
- Promoting joint application of universities and enterprises in Horizon Europe through the University Innovation Ecosystem (EIÖ) call
- Gradually introducing and promoting the Horizon Europe scheme structure and evaluation system (including English language application process) in the Hungarian RDI funding system
