The Green Deal Call

- <u>Directly relevant to the Green Deal objectives</u>
- Aim:
 - to produce tangible results,
 - visible to the citizens,
 - in a relatively <u>short time</u> frame.
- To increase impact and visibility, proposed actions should be <u>limited in number</u> supporting primarily <u>innovation and</u> <u>demonstration</u> actions.
- Emphasis would be given to <u>systemic</u>, <u>cross-sectoral</u> approaches. Take-up of Council recommendations (10/12/2019) to use the approach on *transformative change of the UN SDG report*
